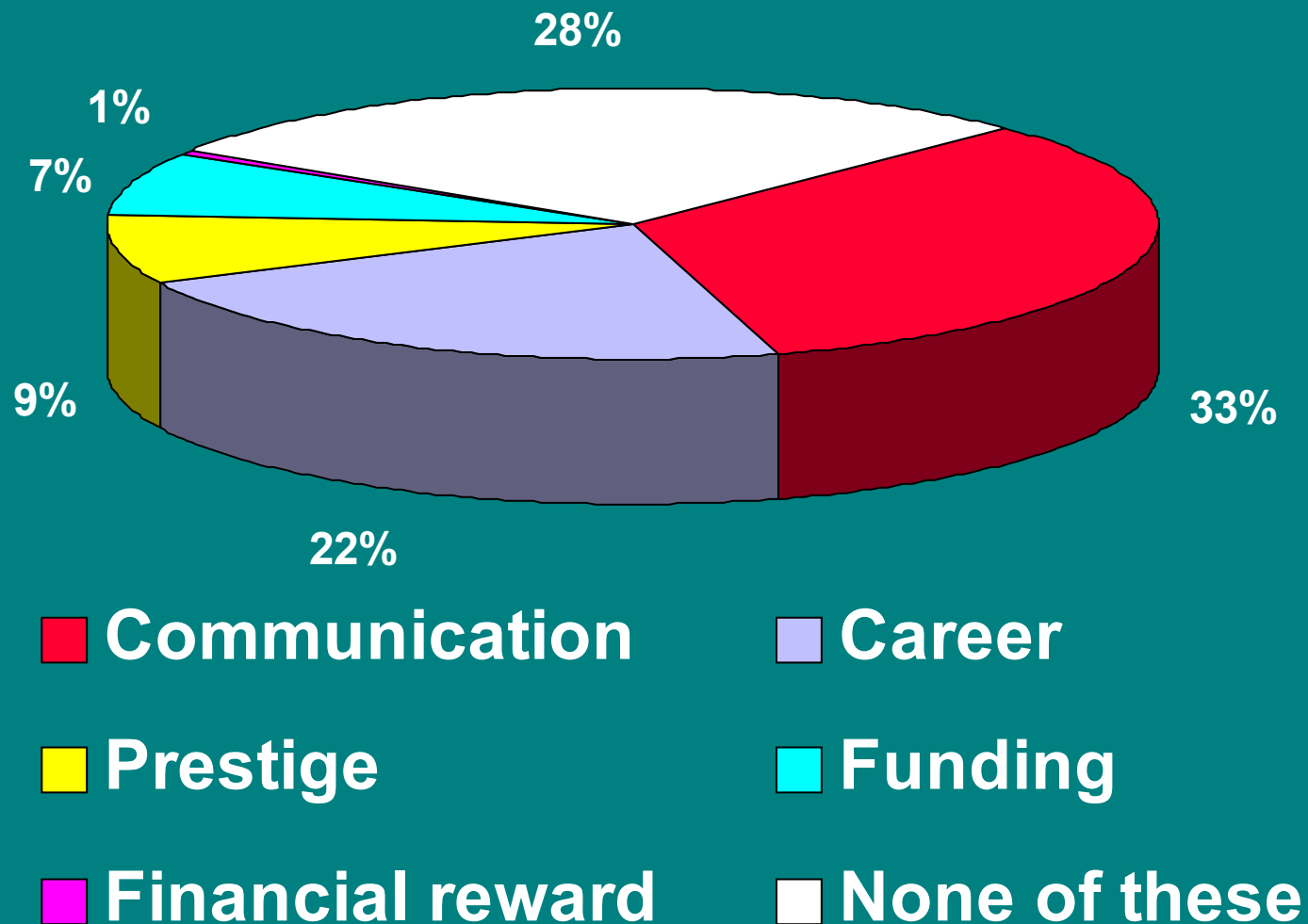
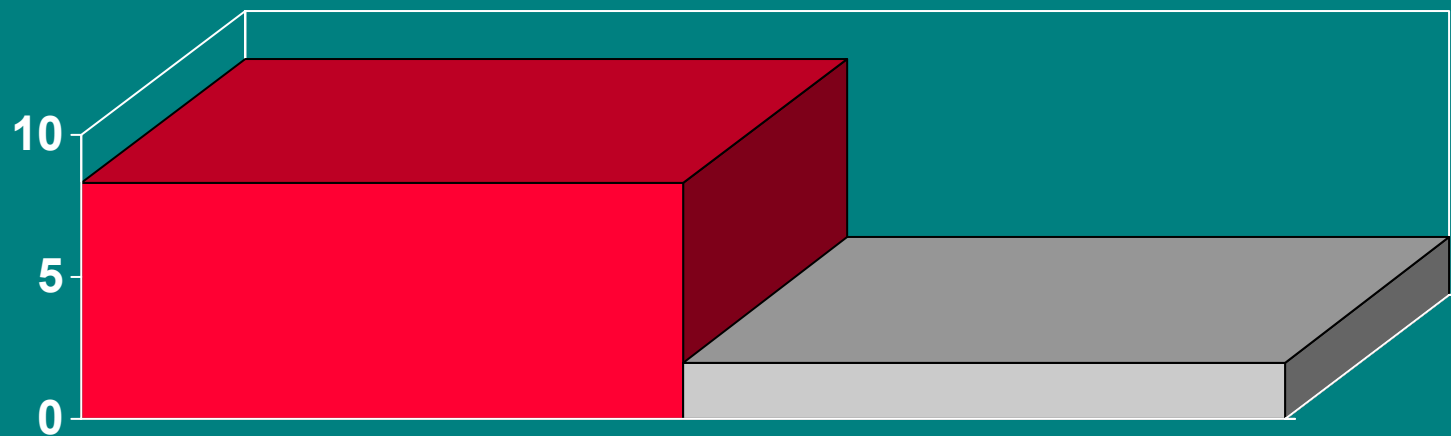


Fig. 2: Relative importance of funding

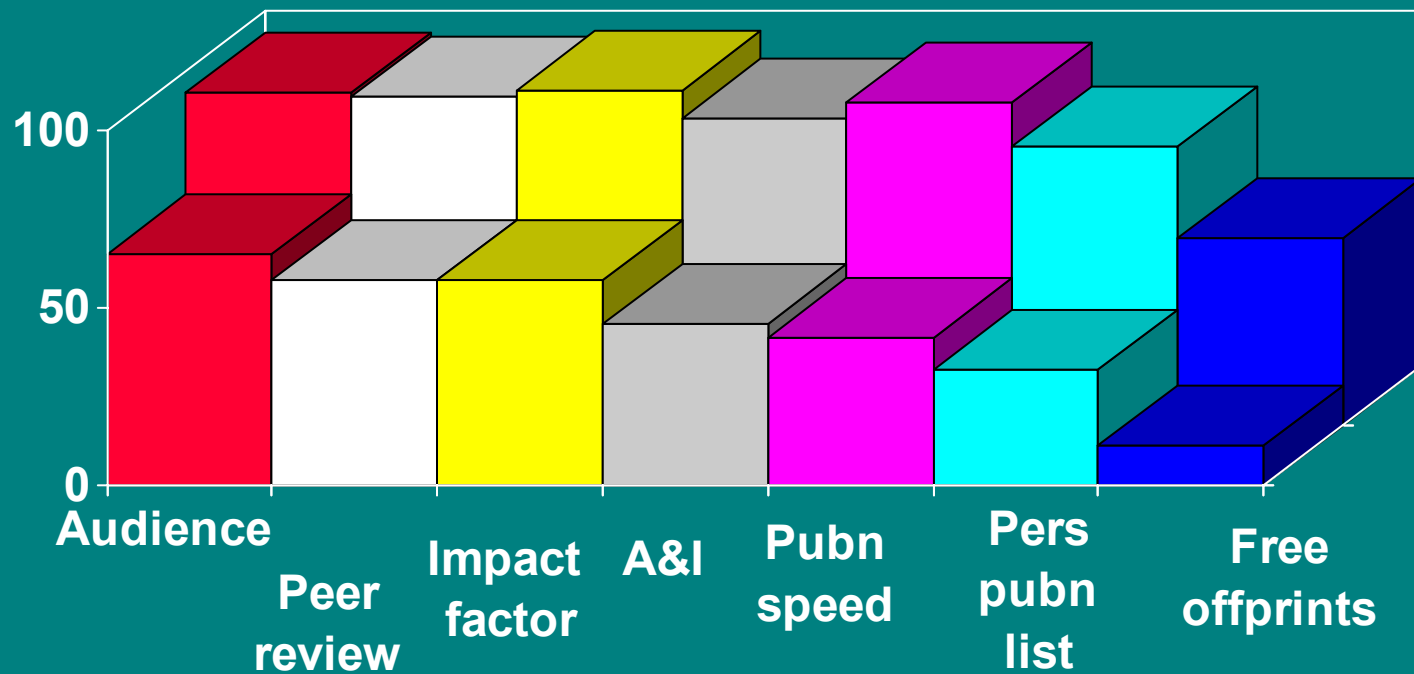


Fig. 4: Submission decision factors

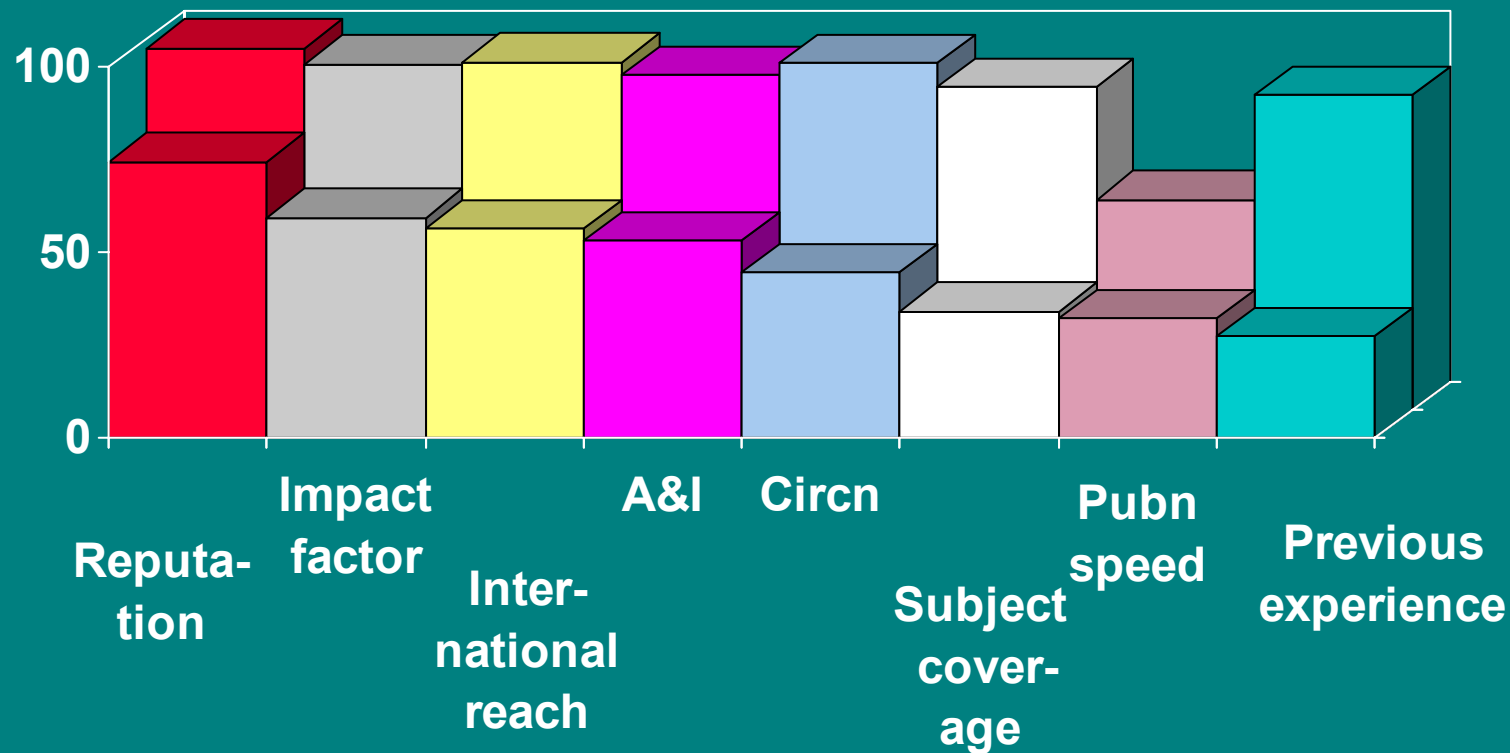


Fig. 5: Electronic availability and submission

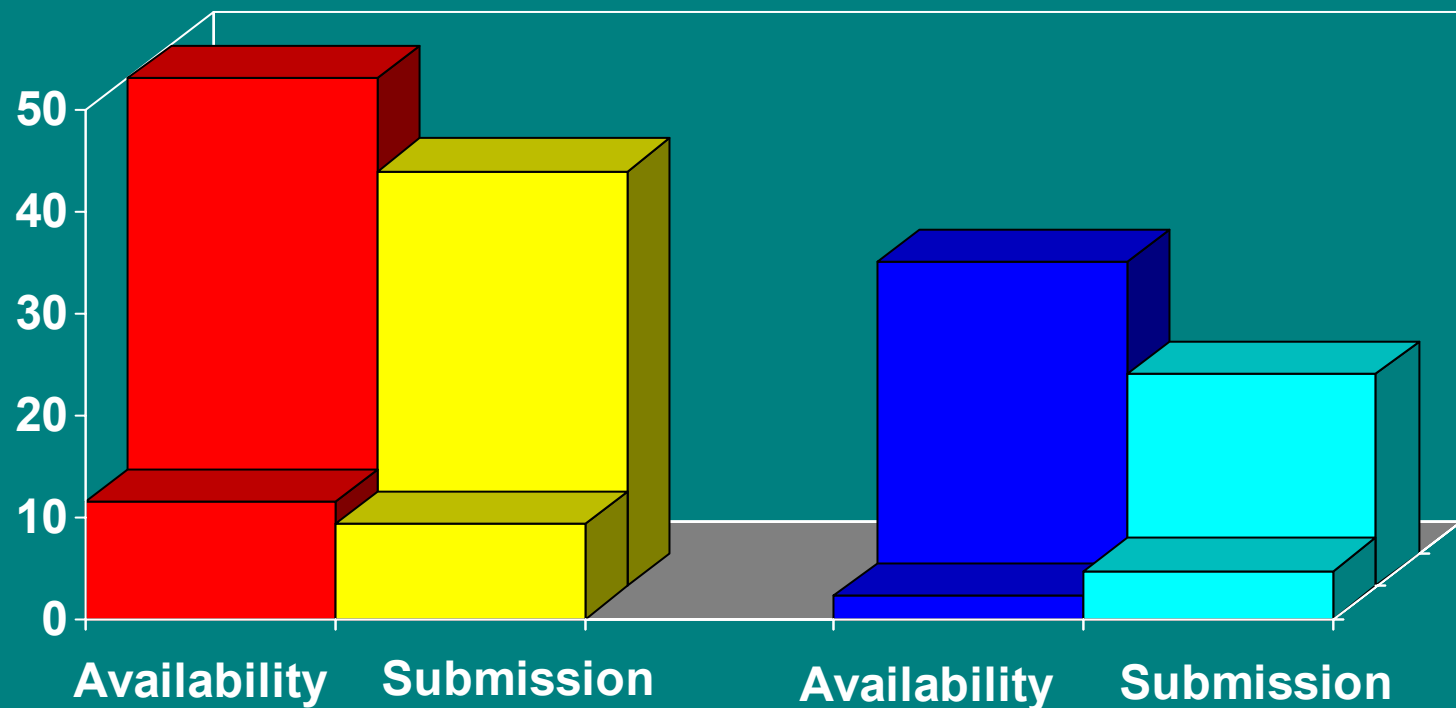


Fig. 6: Publication speed

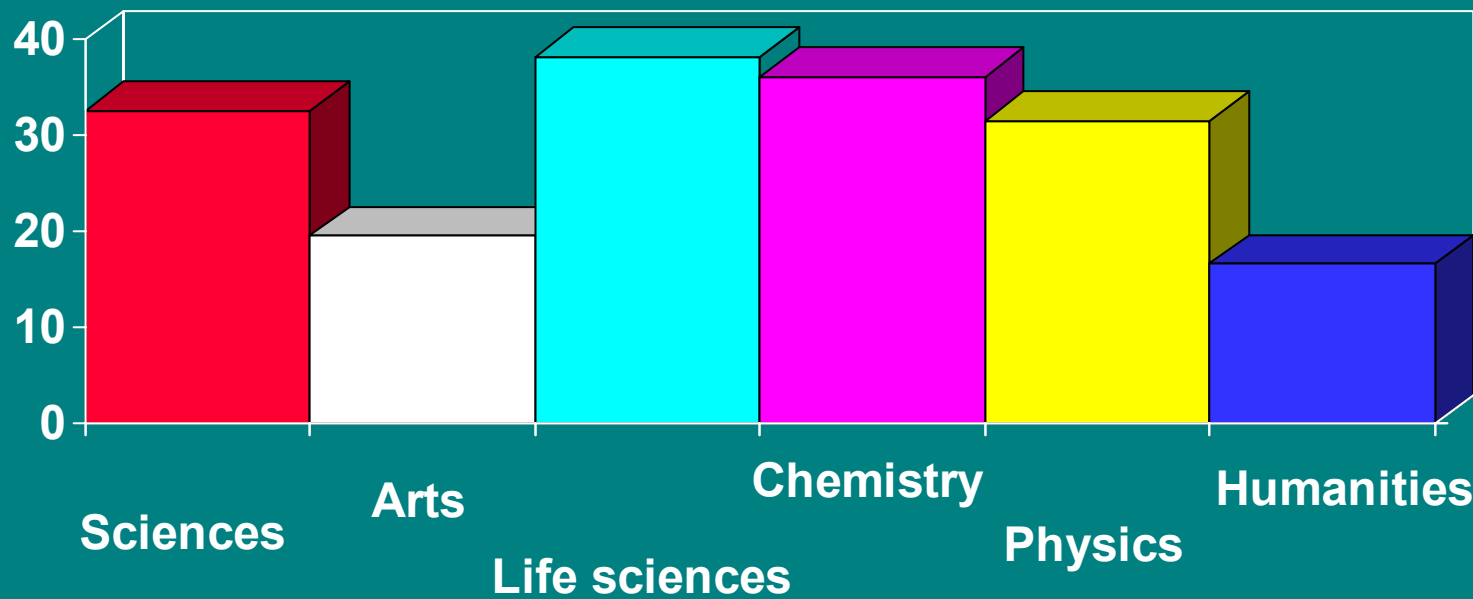


Fig.7: Impact factors: ignorance of where to find them

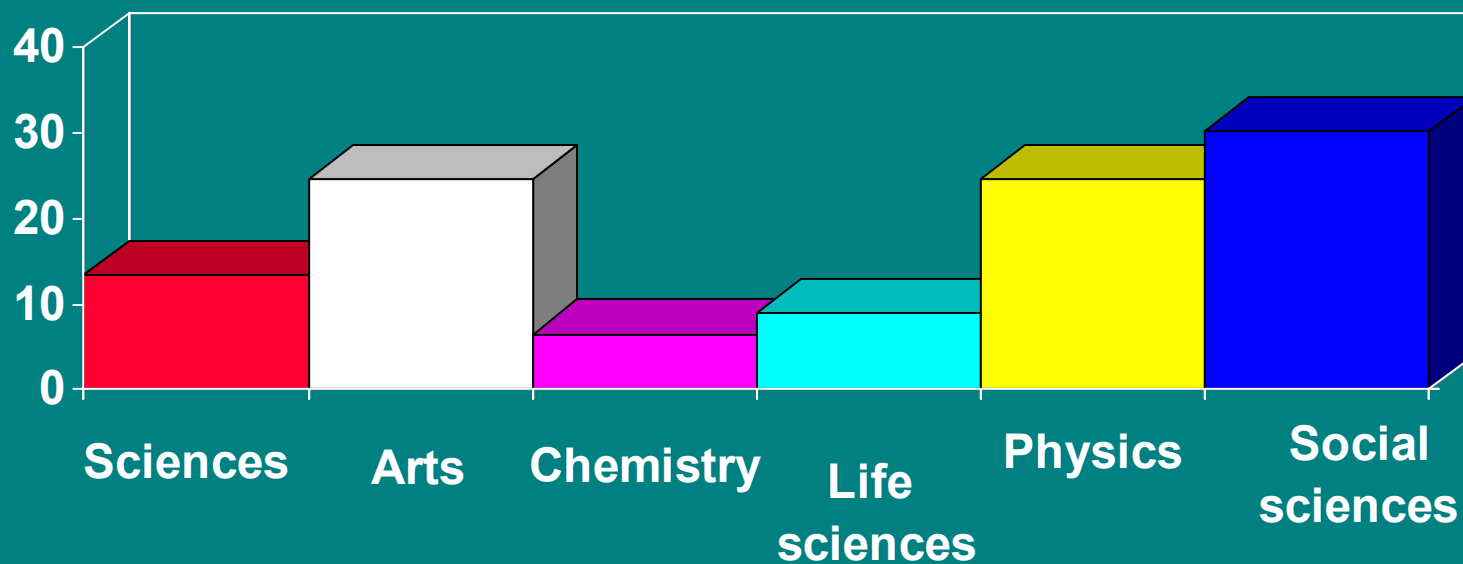


Fig.8: Abstracting and indexing services: ignorance of where to find their coverage

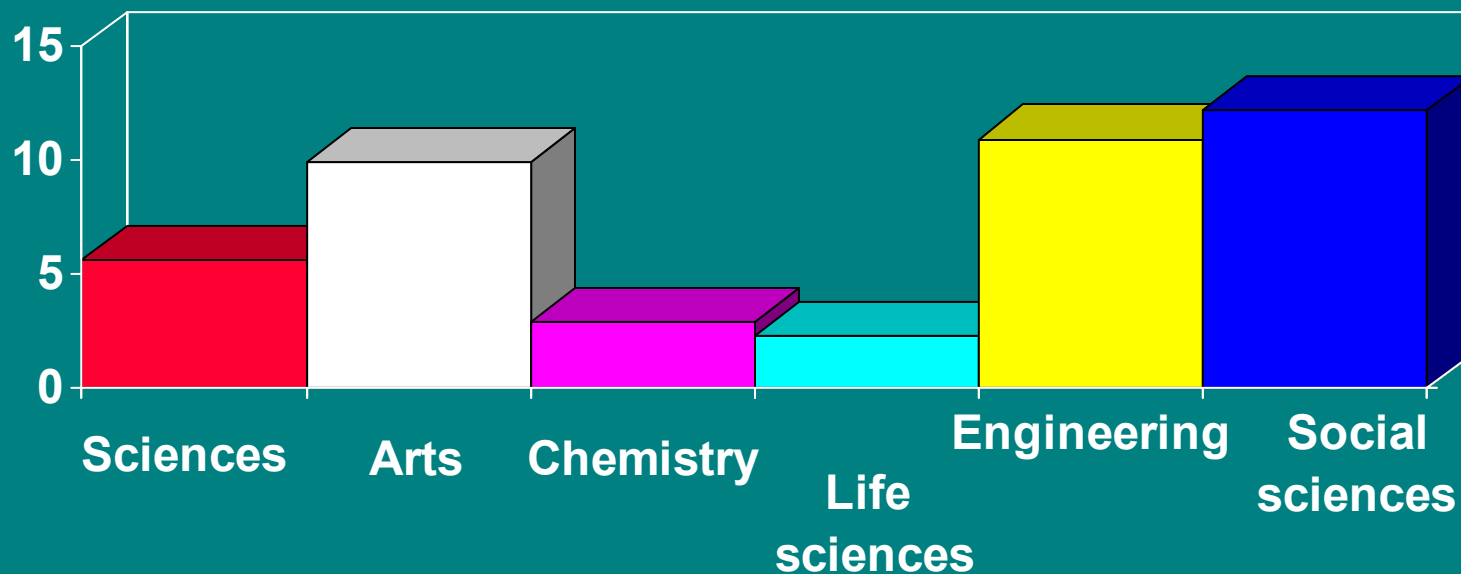


Fig.9: Circulation figures: do authors check them?

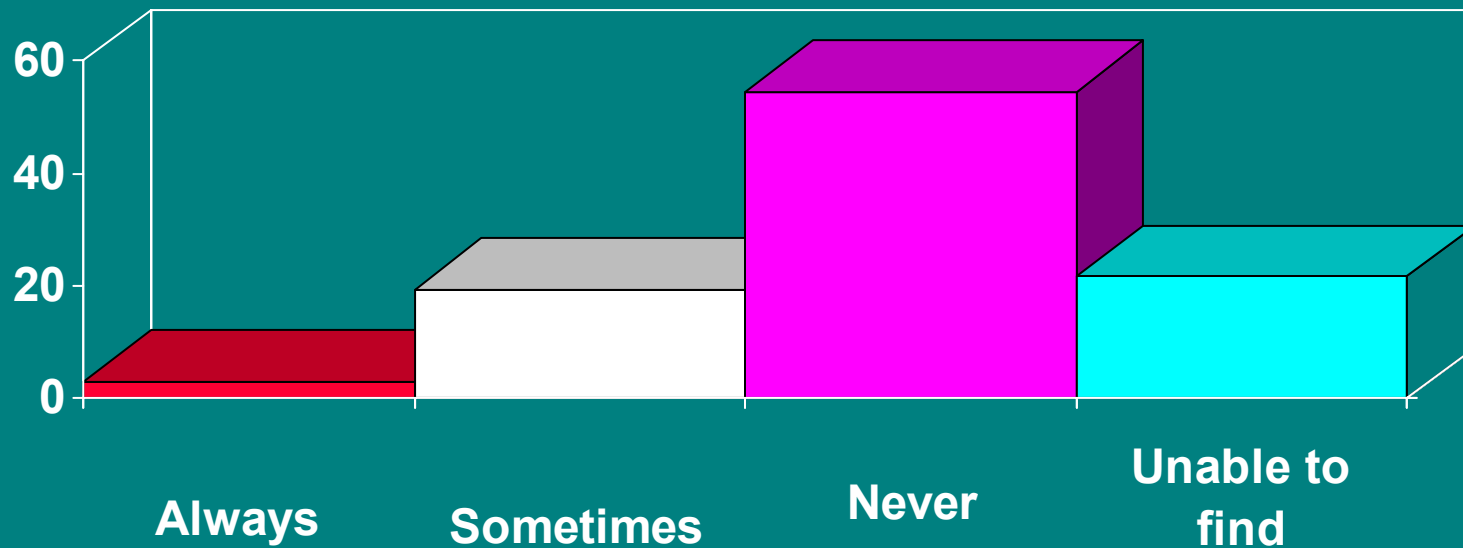


Fig.10: Page charges: who pays?

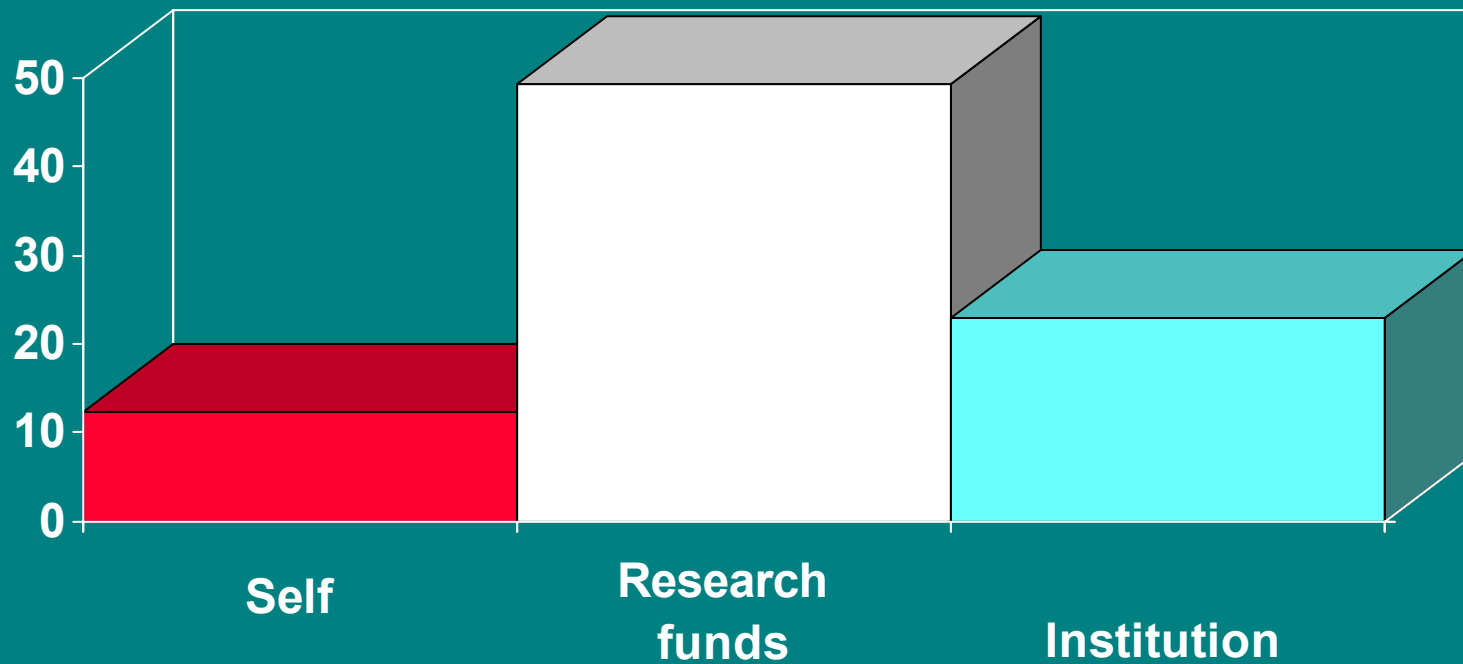


Fig.11: Disseminating results

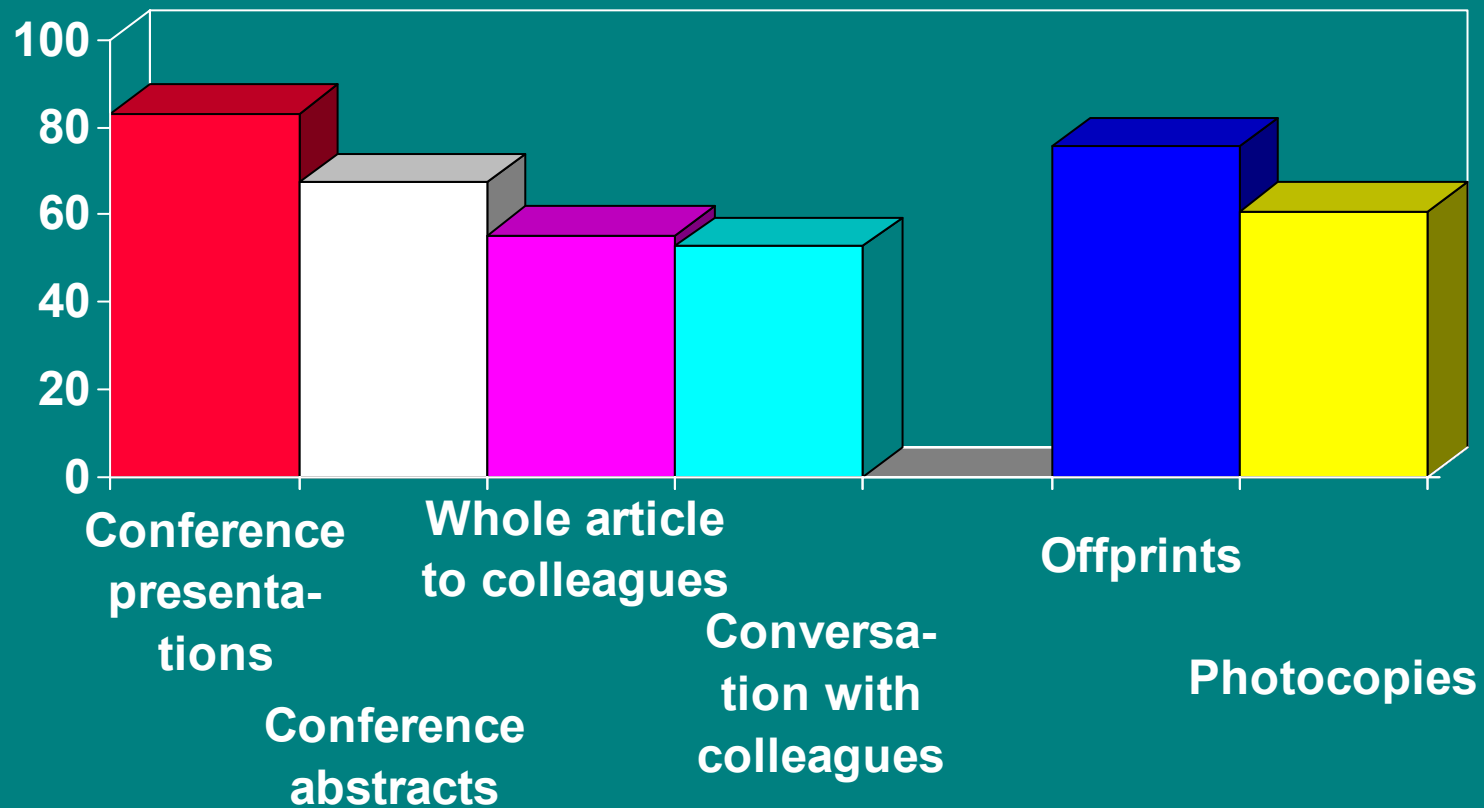


Fig.12: Major obstacles to achieving publishing objectives

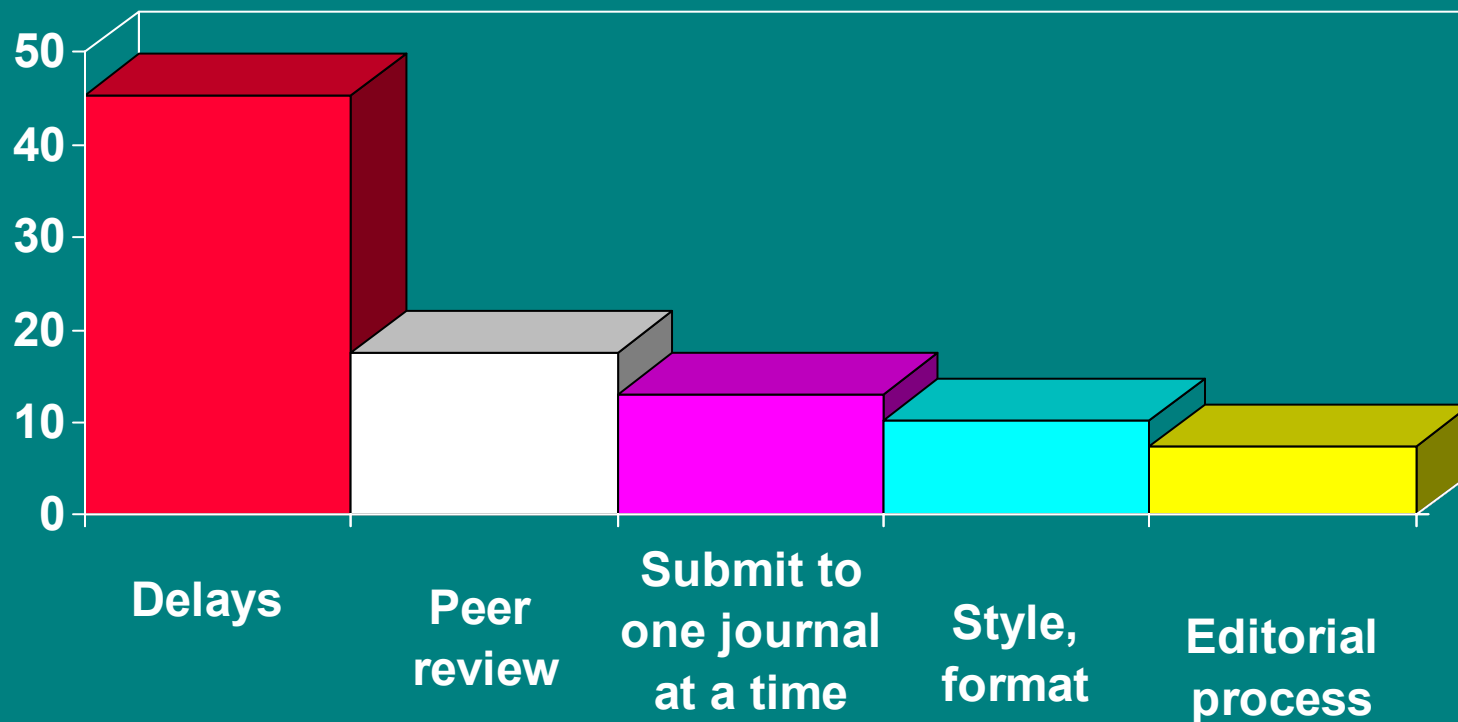


Fig.13: Copyright: who should hold it?

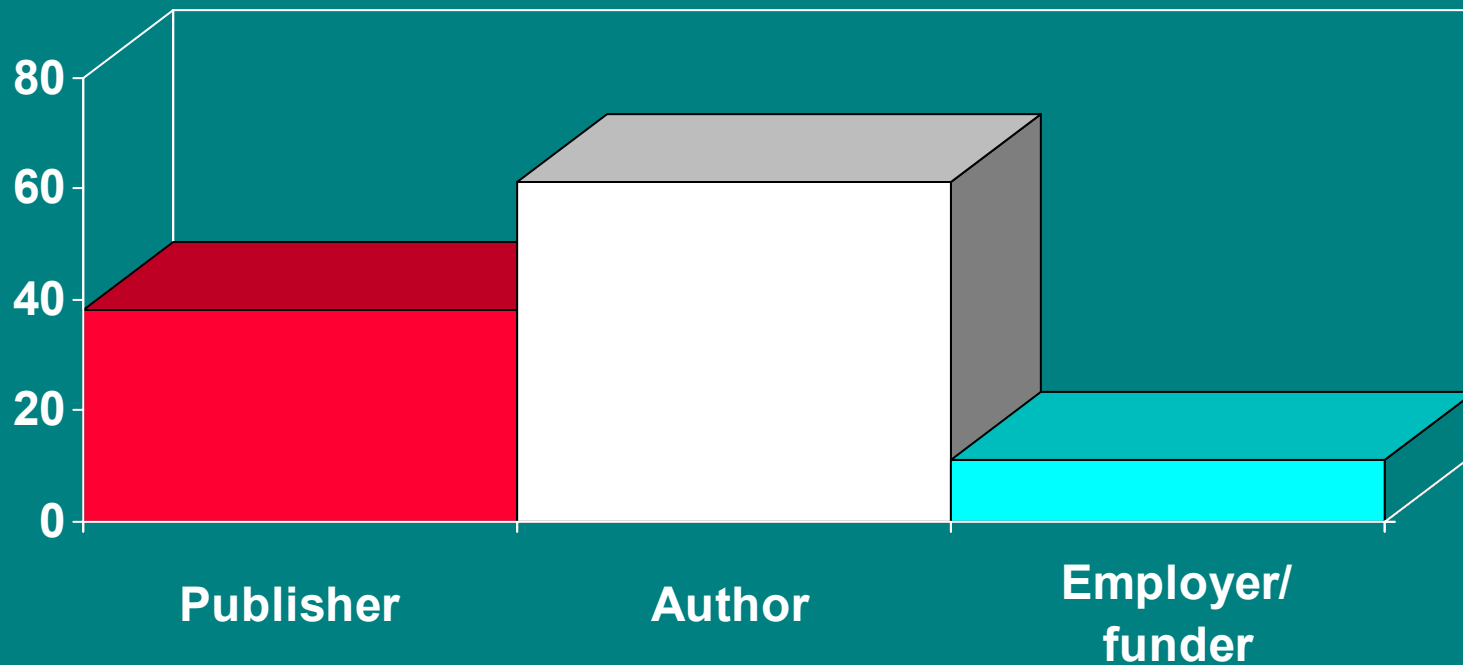


Fig.14: Publishing delays: main concerns

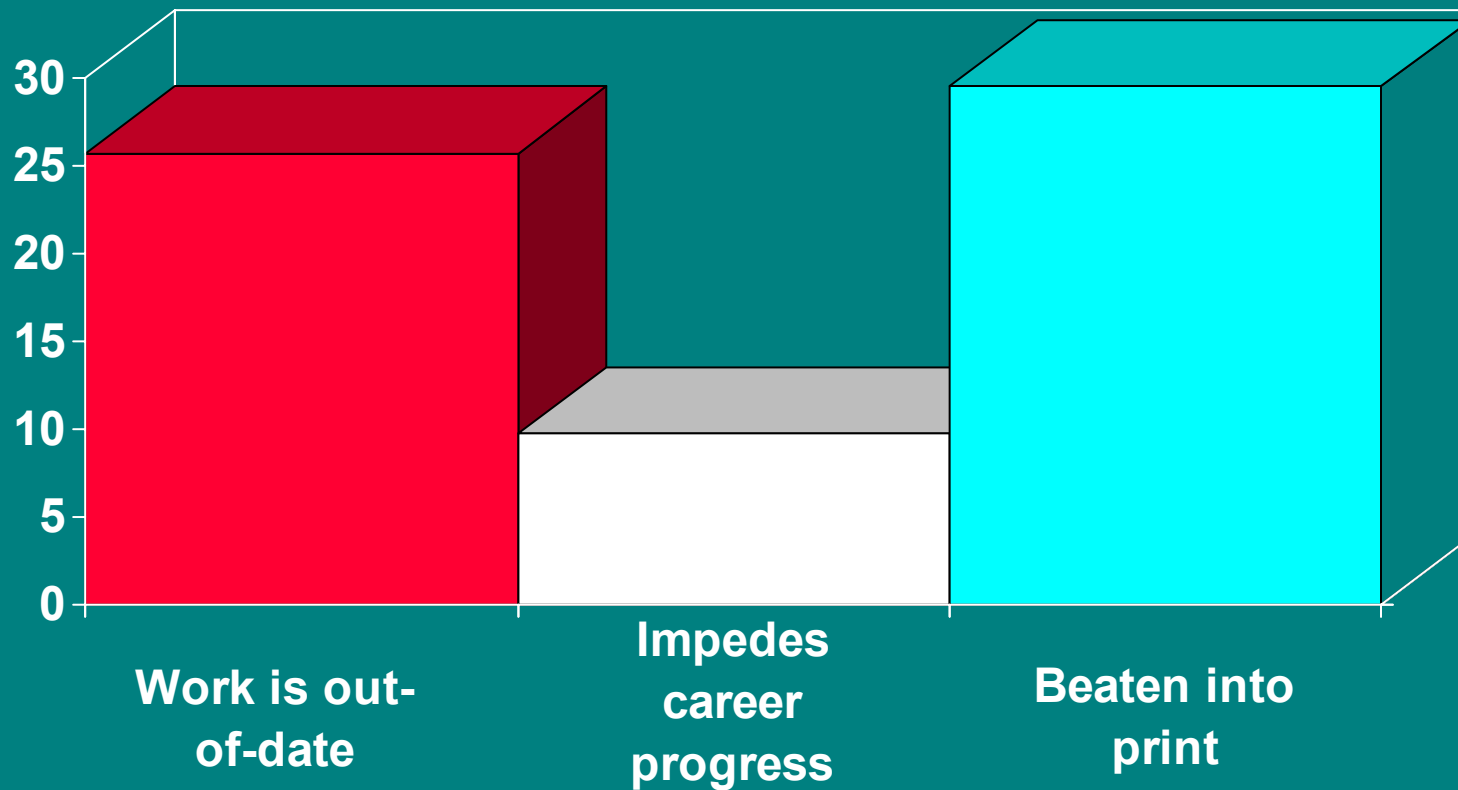


Fig.15: Peer review: authors' reasons for concern

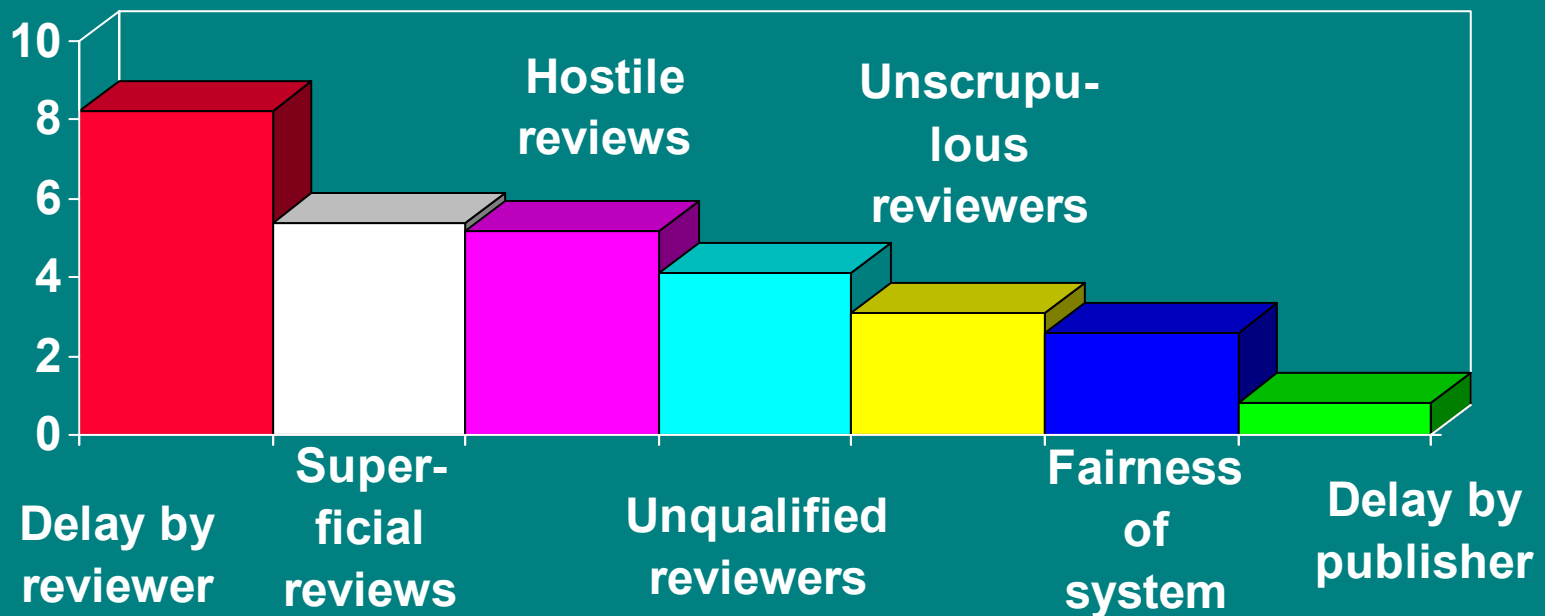


Fig.16: Peer review: reviewers' causes for concern

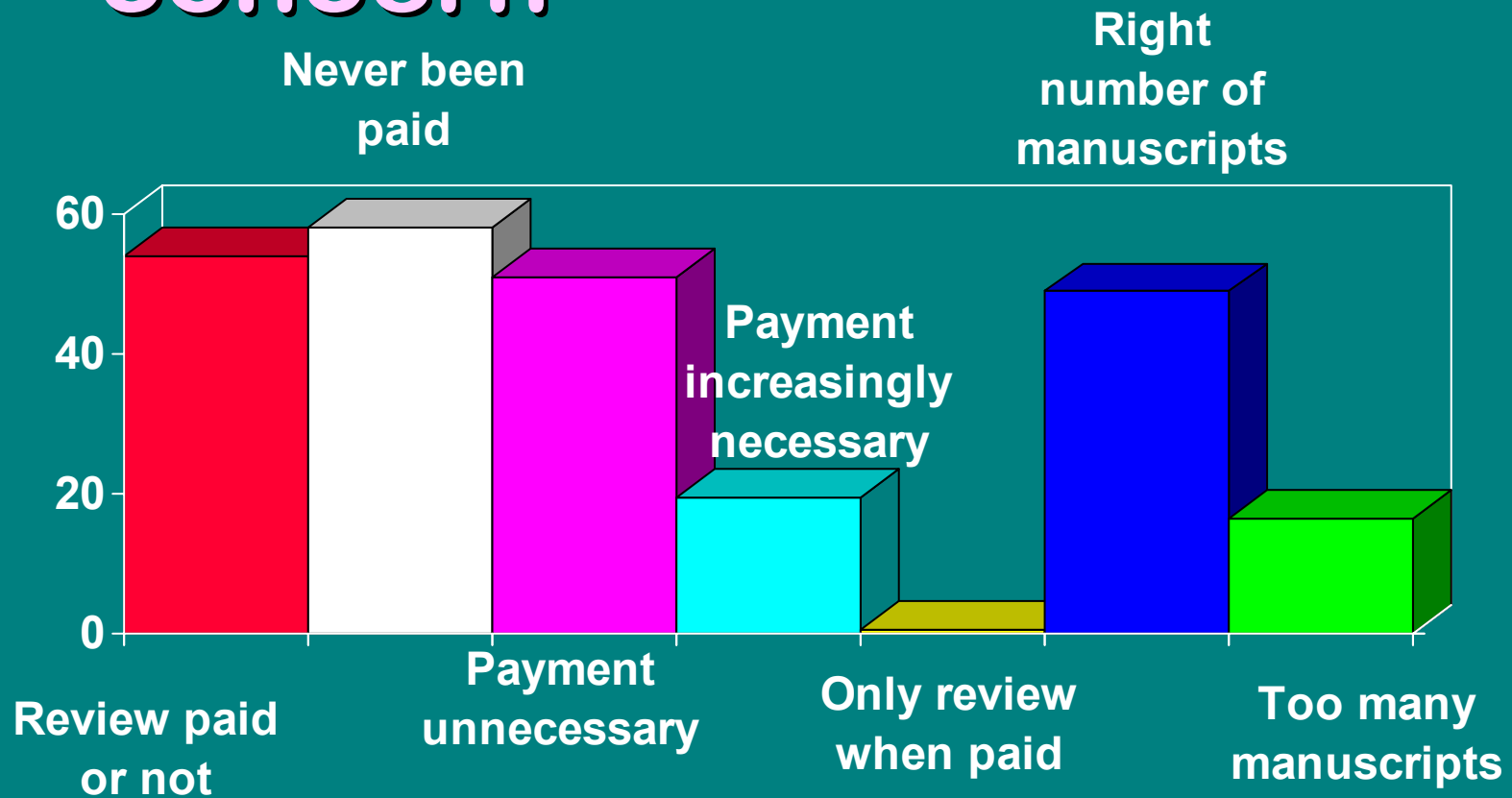


Fig.17: The future: expectations and hopes

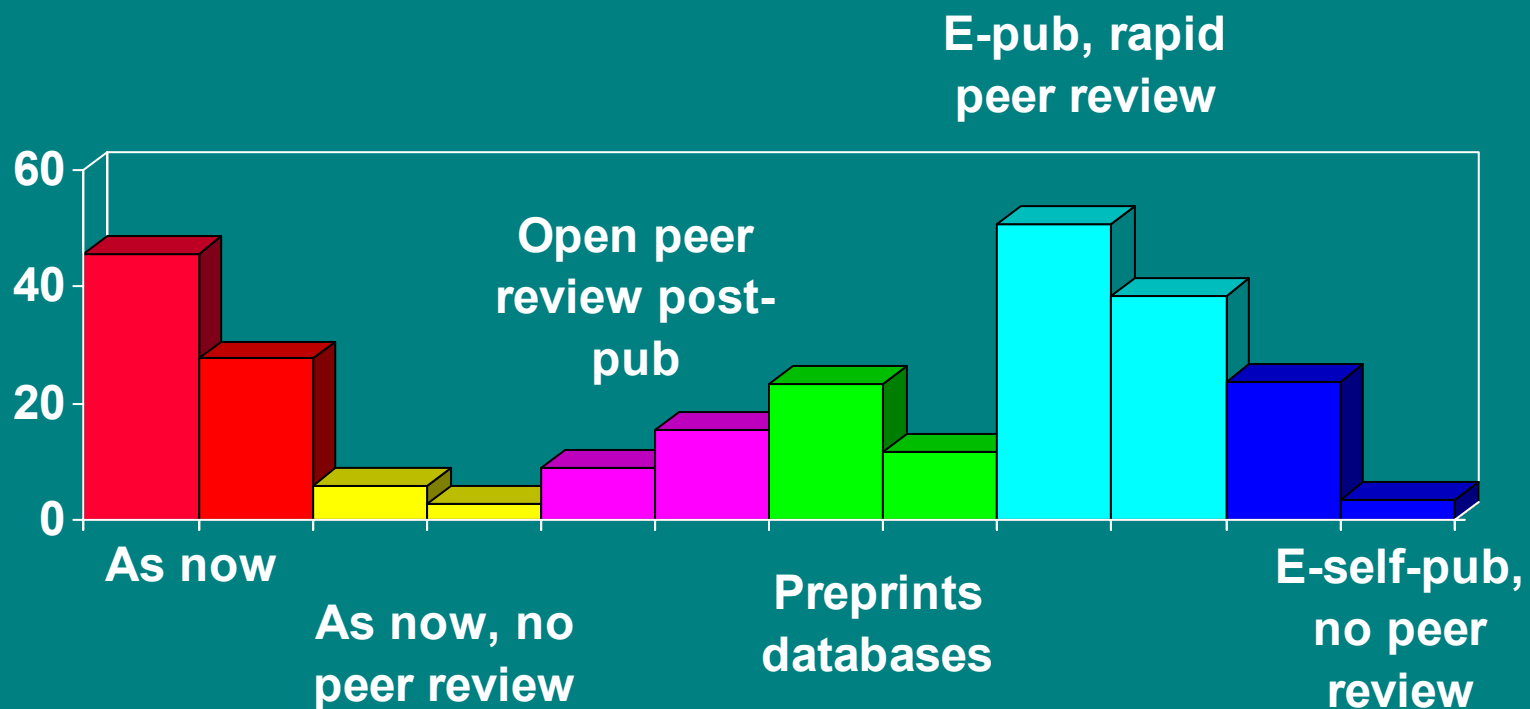


Fig.18: The purpose of scholarly publishing is to build an author's CV/resume
